Day of treatment: what to expect

A plain-language timeline for patients and caregivers covering arrival, treatment, and discharge.

Before you arrive

- Eat normally unless your team tells you otherwise.
- Bring a list of all medications you're currently taking.
- Plan for someone to drive you home if that's been recommended.

Arrival & check-in

You'll check in like any other appointment. The team will review your recent labs, confirm your consent, and walk you through what's about to happen.

In the treatment room

You'll be in a designated room used for this kind of therapy. The team will set up an IV, then give the medicine slowly through it. The infusion itself is short. They'll be with you throughout.

After the infusion

You'll be monitored for a brief period. The team will then walk you through your at-home guidance and answer any questions before you leave.

Going home

You'll get a written handout covering the first 24–48 hours at home, plus a phone number to call with any questions.
